NOMINATION GUIDELINES

Nominations for the 2010 CELA Excellence in Teaching Award are now being accepted.

All nomination packages must be postmarked by February 22, 2010!

The following are the categories and criteria for this award.

EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING AWARD—Up to two awards presented annually—one to a junior faculty (3-10 years teaching experience) and one to a senior faculty (+10 years teaching experience). This award recognizes excellence in creative, innovative and effective teaching methodologies and practice.

Nomination Requirements:

- A faculty member of a CELA member school with a minimum of two years at the nominating institution
- Each institution may nominate one individual

Nomination Package Requirements:

- A standard submission cover page with nominee's name, member institution, award category, and table of contents
- Curriculum Vitae
- Nomination letter (maximum of two pages) from a person associated with a CELA member school that contains the rationale for the nomination
- Three additional letters of support from departmental faculty or administrators

Supporting Materials:

- Autobiographical sketch that summarizes the nominee's teaching philosophy that includes effective teaching strategies and methodologies used by the nominee to enhance excellence in teaching
- Four to six student/alum testimonials
- May include: teaching evaluations, course syllabi, selected examples of student work, publications

Submit SIX (6) copies of all nomination materials bound in three-ring binders to CELA's Executive Director for distribution to Awards Committee.
