Evaluation

Reviewers will evaluate the scholarship application based on a letter of introduction, a resume, work samples, and an essay. All materials are required to be considered for evaluation. They will be evaluated as follows:

- Letter of introduction: A brief letter of introduction prepared by a faculty member will be used to understand the student's impact on the program, making them stand out as a Fountain Scholar. It should also include (but not be limited to) references to accomplishments outlined in the student's resume, portfolio, and essay.
- Resume: The resume will serve as a snapshot of the student's accomplishments. Reviewers will focus on life experiences that are appropriately impactful and inform the essay.
- Work Samples: Written (short samples or excerpts) or graphic samples will be examined to determine the student's ability to communicate their goals and crafted intentions. Emphasis will be placed on work that aligns with the thesis stated within the essay.
- Essay: The essay will be evaluated to ascertain the student's understanding of Dr. Charles Fountain's legacy and impact on the profession and the student's goals.
